PORTRUSH KERR STREET

PROJECT OVERVIEW & CHALLENGES

The scheme involved improvements and enhancements to an area which serves as a pedestrian corridor between the town centre and the historic harbour area.

The existing public space had become tired and worn out in nature.



- · Footway reconfiguration with resurfacing.
- Footway upgrades inc. new granite style kerbing and surfacing with natural paving bands, asphalt and 1,100sqm of exposed aggregate concrete.
- Complete replacement and enhancement of street lighting with LED lamps and columns incorporating fixtures for festive lighting.
- · Installation of a seating wall.
- · Soft landscaping including native marram grass to steep bank.
- Supply and installation of street furniture inc. bins, custom fabricated benches and wheelchair accessible picnic tables.
- Natural basalt stonework to top of harbour wall and alterations to existing stonewall on Kerr Street.
- Placement of a granite compass feature close to the historic harbour.
- · Stainless steel railings along length of harbour wall.

OUR CHALLENGES

Portrush Lifeboat Station, within the site boundary on Kerr Street, required continual engagement with RNLI ensuring access was unhindered in case of emergencies.



OUR SOLUTION

The works were phased and squads were informed as part of the daily toolbox talk to maintain a state of readiness to move plant when required to allow access for the RNLI.

A nominated site representative was provided with a pager from RNLI to alert operatives in case of emergency so that access could be maintained for the lifeboat team at all times.
