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### **PROJECT OVERVIEW & CHALLENGES**

The project comprised environmental improvements to improve public realms at two locations within Tandragee and one within Waringstown. The works within each settlement comprise the following.

### **TANDRAGEE**

### THE MALL:

Public realm improvement works to a raised footway area adjacent to the historic walls surrounding Tandragee Castle, the home of the Tayto crisp factory. The works included new decorative railings, upgrades to steps including handrails and demarcation surfacing, resurfacing, timber seating, bins and decorative epoxy bound surfacing.



Public realm and open space improvement work to an existing public space which had become tired and worn out in nature. Works included new decorative brick paving to paths and circular amenity areas, seating, a bespoke feature column-mounted clock, trees, and soft landscaping.

### WARINGSTOWN

This scheme involved Public Realm improvement works to all footways surrounding the main junction in the town. All footways surrounding the junction were excavated and reconstructed with granite kerbing and sandstone paving. Street lighting was replaced. New street furniture in the form of bins and benches were added to enhance the appearance of the area for locals and passing motorists.
